# PROGRAM DESCRIPTIONS

## SESSION I - DR. KERRI TAYLOR & DR. RYAN LYNCH

The microscope. DNA. Soft-serve ice cream. Beer. “Rock Stars of Science” is a course focusing on the history of science with a particular focus in chemistry and the teams of researchers behind scientific innovation. Together, we will explore the universities of Oxford and Cambridge and the city of London to look at the context and legacy of scientific progress in England. We will learn about the history of the region and the importance of these discoveries to society. Students of all majors will be discussing the actual science behind these developments and their applicability to the modern world.

## SESSION II - DR. CINDY TICKNOR

During the “Age of Reason” in the 18th century, the public sphere had increased access to new knowledge in math, science, music and art. In this period great thinkers challenged traditional religious and political authorities about what it meant to “know” the world. This course will immerse students in the culture, philosophies and political climate of the era by visiting historical sites, attending performances, and re-creating great conversations held in public houses. Sites will include Oxford, London, Cambridge and Bath.

## SESSION III - PROF. DAVID TURNER

Offers students the chance to study the life and selected works of William Shakespeare and experience live productions, travel to historic sites and even perform a little Shakespeare in the English countryside. The course will involve a visit to Shakespeare’s birthplace in Stratford upon Avon, tours and performances at both the Royal Shakespeare Company and Shakespeare’s Globe Theatre, opportunities to see other shows in London and Oxford, and explorations of pertinent museums related to Elizabethan life.



## COSTS

Roundtrip airfare, course related transport between Oxford and London, special guest lectures, field trips, Oxford city bus pass, housing at CSU’s Spencer House, & insurance.
